Hope For Children

Hope For Children’s (HFC) objective is to provide a healthy and happy environment for the youth of Ethiopia and develop HIV prevention, care and support to empower communities.

Hope For Children and their partner organizations Birhan Integrated Community Development Organization (BICDO) and New Vision in Education Association (NVEA) received a grant of \$299,661.11 that they use to implement projects in the target sectors of Agriculture, Education, Health, Rural Roads, Water and Sanitation.

The Social Accountability tools of Community Score Card and Participatory Planning and Budgeting are implemented and used in 4 woredas in Oromiya (Babile, Bona, Sibule, Bako Tibe) and 1 woreda in the Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples Region (Shebedino).

HFC, BICDO and NVEA outlined different approaches of how to introduce and promote Social Accountability, especially when it comes to youth, women, people living with HIV, the elderly and the disabled. One of these approaches is to promote awareness among service providers on the inclusion of these groups. Another approach is to involve the vulnerable groups in assessments and surveys to identify gaps and forward suggestions as how to ensure better service delivery.

The outcomes of the implemented Social Accountability projects by HFC and its partner organizations will include improved monitoring and evaluation of basic public service delivery, both at the community level and the woreda level and proactive participation of local communities.

HFC was established in 2000 and has ever since implemented numerous projects with components of capacity building, community empowerment, raising awareness and reduction of poverty.
