

"Creating a society where women are free from all forms of discrimination and violence."

Kembati Menti Gezima (KMG Ethiopia) implements community based integrated development programs that focus on women empowerment by using the community capacity enhancement approach through community conversations. This enables communities to explore, identify and prioritize its problems and develop plans for action.

With the \$156,851.79 grant, Social Accountability projects are implemented in 4 woredas in the Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples Region (Angecha, Hederron Tunto, Damboya) in the target sectors of Education and Health.

Community Score Card is the Social Accountability tool used by KMG Ethiopia to implement the projects and improve community attitudes towards the role of service providers and its own role in improving service delivery. Additionally, the projects increase the demand and commitment among the communities for addressing their priority needs in service delivery and raise awareness on health related issues to bring about behavioral change and transformation.

A total of 47.490 people will benefit over the next two years by the Social Accountability programs implemented by KMG Ethiopia. The main beneficiaries are women, young people and the elderly. KMG Ethiopia was established in 1997 and focuses on creating a society where women are free from all forms of discrimination and violence and are able to attain equity and equality for themselves and societies at large through integrated and sustainable development interventions that link society, economy and ecology.
