ove in Action (LIA) aims to change the livelihoods of poor and marginalized people in rural areas, by focusing on education, capacity and health related issues. The approach of LIA is to have as little as possible external intervention but to provide people with the needed social accountability tools.

With the \$297,598.15 grant that the organization received from ESAP2, Love in Action will use social accountability tools such as the Community Score Card, Participatory Planning and Budgeting, and Citizens' Reports Cards to ensure more effective and efficient basic services.

Love In Action is working towards ensuring accountability of local governments to communities and increasing the understanding of accountability to citizens during the 18 months project in the target sectors of Agriculture, Education and Water and Sanitation.

Love in Action works together on grassroots level with their partners Passage for Aid and Development Association (PADA) and with Green Message for Ethiopia Development Association (GEMDA). PADA has a history of implementing projects that relate to child care and support while GEMDA is known for projects relating to water supply and sanitation and giving trainings to build capacity.

Love In Action works in 2 woredas in Oromiya (West Badawacho, Adaba) and in 3 woredas in the Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples Region (East Badawacho, Misha, Gibe) where their staff is working closely together with almost 1000 volunteers. With the efforts of Love In Action, over 15.000 children and 6500 adults received basic education, economic and health related support since the establishment of the organization in 2001.
