

# Migbare-Senay Children and Family Support Organization

Migbare-Senay Children and Family Support Organization’s (MSCFSO) mission is to contribute towards improving socio-economic development and bring better livelihood through children and family support.

The organization works together with its partner organizations Afro Ethiopia Integrated Development Organization (AEIDA) and Enarjenawga Development Association (ENDA) in 5 woredas in the Amhara region (Aneded, Machakel, Semen Achefer, Enemay, Enarjenawga).

AEIDA’s expertise is in mobilizing communities for the development of potable water sources and provision of sanitary services. ENDA has rich experience in mobilizing communities for deforestation, rehabilitation of degraded land, education and health sectors.

With the \$298,991 grant received, the three partner organizations are implementing projects in the sectors of Agriculture, Education, Health, Water and Sanitation. The Social Accountability tools used for communities to claim their engagement and entitlements in accessing quality services are the Community Score Card and Citizens’ Report Card.

To enable citizens to use Social Accountability tools to claim their engagement and entitlements in accessing quality public basic services, consultative sessions, workshops and interface meetings will be organized over the next two years. The projects will specifically focus on women, girls, children and people with disabilities to empower them to voice their needs in the provision of public basic services.

MSCFSO is experienced in mobilizing communities and working together with governments to implement their projects. The organization was awarded in 2011 with the Green Award Program for implementing projects relating to natural resource development and protection.
