

## Non State Actors Coalition

"To realize tripartite dialogue for the formulation, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of development partnerships and cooperation issues to realize sustainable development of the country."

on State Actors Coalition (NSAC) is a consortium of over forty Ethiopian charities to promote dialogue for the formulation, implementation and evaluation of development partnerships and cooperation issues for sustainable development in the country.

The \$300,000 grant rewarded is used to implement Social Accountability projects together with its partners Community Development Service Association (CDSA) and Wako Guta Foundation (WGF). CDSA focuses mostly on the disadvantaged groups in both rural and urban poor communities, while WGF support mostly goes out to pastoralist communities.

The projects focus on Agriculture, Health, Rural Roads, Water and Sanitation. The three partner organizations are actively implementing Social Accountability programs in 2 woredas in Somali (Kebribeyah, Tulu Guled) and 3 woredas in Oromiya (Chinaksen, Mena, Madda Walabu).

The Social Accountability tools, Community Score Card, Citizens' Report Card and Gender Responsive Budgeting will be used to contribute to good governance. Activities such as dialogue forums, trainings, workshops and establishing steering committees will create conducive environment for vulnerable groups to participate in the stages of implementation, monitoring and evaluation.

The projects will create empowered citizens and citizens groups who are aware of their rights but also of their responsibilities to contribute to and demand better quality public basic service delivery, demands projects that are sustainable. The projects will achieve creating sustainable empowered communities by establishing databases. After finishing the two-year project, the data for planning, research and the use of Social Accountability tools will be handed over to the Woredas.

NSAC was established in 2004 and is the lead organizations to realize the Social Accountability programs. Partner organizations CDSA and WGF are the implementing partners, working on grass roots level in the specific woredas.
