Oromia Development Association (ODA) envisions a society where all people are empowered, educated, healthy and live in a prosperous and green environment. The organization is working towards this goal by integrated community based programs that primarily focus on livelihoods improvement and empowerment.

The organization will implement Social Accountability projects over the next two years that focus on Agriculture, Health, Water and Sanitation. The Social Accountability projects are funded from the \$299,943.96 grant and are implemented in 5 woredas in the Oromiya region (Adama Town, Adama, A/J/K, Fantale, Shala).

The projects of ODA include activities such as producing tool kits for incorporating gender issues in all projects, undertake capacity building training to enhance managements of local community organizations and establish public transparency boards to encourage effective utilization of recourses by all stakeholders.

The main Social Accountability tools used by Oromia Development Association is the Community Score Card.

Additionally, 30,000 educational materials on Social Accountability will be produced and distributed, 700 community representatives will be trained, 90 interface meetings and public hearings will be conducted, 90 participatory planning session will be conducted over the coming two years. This will result in to programs that include the views of citizens, increased quality of public basic services and ensure transparent and downward accountability.

ODA was established in 1993 to address chronic socio-economic problems prevalent in the Oromiya region by working together with all stakeholders involved, especially with the respective government officials.
