Professional Alliance for Development (PADet) envisions a transformed society where children, youth and women enjoy decent life by serving them and the most vulnerable and marginalized segments of the population through participatory community based development programs.

PADet works together with partner organization Save Your Generation Ethiopia (SYGE) to achieve citizens’ participation, downward accountability and responsiveness of public policy making, public budgeting and the delivery of public basic services.

With the \$299,621.62 grant, the two partner organizations are implementing Social Accountability projects in 3 woredas in Oromiya (Degem, Wuchale, Jidda) and 2 woredas in Addis Ababa City Administration (Lideta, Kirkos).

The Social Accountability tools used are Community Score Card and Citizens’ Report Card. Projects implemented by PADet and SYGE over the next two years focus on the target sectors of Agriculture, Health, Water and Sanitation.

Enhancing good governance is done through mainstreaming the vulnerable community groups. This will be realized by awareness trainings, establishing forums, building information base and interface meetings.

Professional Alliance for Development was established in 1998 by a group of voluntary development professionals to advance Social Accountability through collaboration, networking and empowerment of citizens.
