Redeem The Generation (RTG) is committed to work for the empowerment of youth and orphan and vulnerable children to release their potential for a better life. The organization prepares them for the challenges in life by providing trainings, health service and psychological support.

Social Accountability projects are being implemented in 2 woredas in Afar (Awash Fentale, Dulesa) and 1 woreda in Oromiya (Metehara Town) over a period of two years. RTG’s projects are targeted on the sectors of Education, Health and Rural Roads with \$236,904 grant.

The Social Accountability tools used are the Community Score Card, and Participatory Planning and Budgeting. Surveys will be conducted before, during and after the projects to be informed about the awareness level about citizens’ attitudes and awareness about their rights

The activities planned by Redeem The Generation include conducting training workshops to service providers to introduce Social Accountability approaches and tools, focused group discussions to ensure a standard performance level of basic service delivery, and mainstream the use of Social Accountability tools and mechanisms to sustain the effects after the projects.

Redeem The Generation started helping orphans and educating youth about HIV in 1999. The organization has tremendous experience in implementing projects that specifically relate to education and health for vulnerable groups.
