Adigrat Diocesan Catholic Church Secretariat (ADCS) promotes integral human development through effective coordination and implementation of pastoral, social and development activities in a sustainable way. Through its Social Accountability project, the organization works to improve the quality of education, health and agricultural extension services provided to targeted communities.

Adigrat Diocesan Catholic Church Secretariat (ADCS) received a \$270,000 grant to implement Social Accountability projects that focus on agriculture, education and health. The Social Accountability tools used by ADC Sare Community Score Card and Participatory Planning and Budgeting.

The organization works in five woredas of the Tigray and Afar regional states, namely; Gulo mekada, Ganta-Afeshum, Irob, Saeseit saeda-emba and Dallol.

The project implemented by ADCS will benefit 14,230 people directly and 100,000 indirectly. The main beneficiaries of the project are women, children, people living with disabilities, people living with HIV/AIDS, and the elderly.
