Addis Development Vision (ADV) has experience in working with the poor at grassroots level and has been engaged in empowering self-help groups, youth associations, and women cooperatives in various development activities including health and sanitation programs, shelter, communal latrine and water construction and maintenance, medical support and income generation schemes.

Before involving in ESAP2's project, ADV's projects aimed at improving the capacities of grassroots organizations such as Community Based Organizations (CBOs) to design and implement programs that promote women's wellbeing and privileges, and enhance the awareness of non-state actors and the public on gender issues. To this effect, the organization coordinated short-term training events on such themes as gender relations, gender analysis and on legal support to victims of violence.

Through its Social Accountability (SA) project, the organization works to support public service providers deliver improved public basic services in different sectors, enhance citizens' awareness on their responsibilities to plan, budget, implement and monitor public basic service delivery and build the capacity of community based organizations on the use of SA tools, approaches and mechanisms.

Addis Development Vision (ADV) received a \$242,100 grant to implement Social Accountability projects that focus on agriculture, education, health, and water and sanitation. The Social Accountability tools used by ADV are Community Score Card and Gender Responsive Budgeting.

The organization works in four Woredas in the Southern Nations, Nationalities and People's regional state namely in Mirab Azerent, Lanfuro, Sanukra and Silti. The project implemented by ADV will benefit 62,778 people directly and 456,825 indirectly. The main beneficiaries of the project are men, women, people living with HIV/AIDS and people with disabilities.

Volunteer Ethiopians, to improve the plight of disadvantaged groups in the country, established Addis Development Vision (ADV) in 1993. The organization strives to see Ethiopia become a place where every citizen enjoys all forms of better life through promoting access to basic health, education and livelihood that can improve their lives.
