Action Professionals' Association for the People (APAP) works to facilitate the organizational development of community and mass based associations and strengthening the capacity of community as well as government and non-government actors. This is to enable them to provide and create access to quality basic socio-economic services to the poor and disadvantaged population.

The organization works in partnership with Organization for Social Development (OSD) and The Society for the Advancement of Human Resources and Environment (SAHRE). Their activities aim to strengthen the use of SA tools, approaches and mechanisms by community structures, local government officials and service providers towards making primary education and maternal and child health service delivery more equitable, effective, efficient, responsive and accountable.

Action Professionals' Association for the People (APAP) received a \$213,068.10 grant to implement Social Accountability projects that focus on education and health. The Social Accountability tools used by APAP are Community Score Card and Participatory Planning and Budgeting. The organization works in three woredas in the Harari, Oromia and Amhara regional state namely in Shenkor, Yabello and Dessie

Town woredas respectively. The project implemented by APAP and its two partner organizations will benefit 12,550 people directly and 36,000 indirectly. The main beneficiaries of the project are women, children and children with disabilities.
