“Reducing poverty and creating a healthy, educated and socially and economically stable society in the country.”

Concern for Integrated Development (CfID) works to create an enabling environment for the communities it works with by facilitating, planning, implementing and monitoring of transformational development activities through their active participation. The organization has an overall experience of 10 years implementing development projects throughout the country. Its core interventions are improving access to social services, particularly health and education, economic empowerment of commercial sex workers and other poor women and girls and reduction of Female Genital Mutilation among other activities. CfID has also been implementing various projects in pastoralist regions including Somali regional state for the last 3 years. Its area of interventions is HIV/AIDS and harmful traditional practices.

Through its Social Accountability project, CfID is working towards the efficient, effective, responsive and accountable delivery of health and educational services in its targeted woredas. Concern for Integrated Development (CfID) received a \$269,965.97 grant to implement Social Accountability projects that focus on education and health. The Social Accountability tools used by CfID are Community Score Card and Participatory Planning and Budgeting.

The organization works in five woredas (Shinele, Errer, Afedem, Hareshine and Aysha) of the Somali regional state. The project implemented by CfID will benefit 20,000 people directly and 40,000 indirectly.

The main beneficiaries of the project are women, children and people living with HIV/AIDS. The organization has previously been engaged in various projects including providing social support for people living with HIV/AIDS and orphan and vulnerable children (OVC), economic empowerment of OVC caregivers in Afar regional state, establishing water sanitation, and hand pump facilities and reduction of female genital mutilation. Concern for Integrated Development (CfID) was founded in 2001 by a group of visionary individuals dedicated to solving the multifaceted social and economic problems in the country.
