Rift Valley Children and Women Development Organization (RCWDO)'s mission is RCWDO works to contribute to sustainable improvement in the quality of life of the marginalized and poor people and ensure their empowerment through proactive engagement of the poor people to fulfill their basic needs and demand their rights to development through integrated participatory development approaches.

Through its Social Accountability project, the organization partners with Africa Development Aid Association (ADAA), Sustainable Environment and Development Action (SEDA) and Emanuel Development Association (EDA) to enhance citizens and citizen groups active engagement in accessing quality basic services under the Growth and Transformation Plan in Ethiopia.

Rift Valley Children and Women Development Organization (RCWDO) received a \$270,000 grant to implement Social Accountability projects that focus on agriculture, education and water and sanitation. The Social Accountability tools used by RCWDO are Community Score Card, Citizen Report Card and Gender Responsive Budgeting.

The organization works in five woredas in Addis Ababa and Oromia regional state namely in Sawena, Legahidha, Kofele, and Bora and in Akaki woreda.

The project implemented by RCWDO will benefit 3,000 people directly and 20,000 indirectly. The main beneficiaries of the project are adult male and female, vulnerable and marginalized groups, children (boys and girls) and youth, and local government offices and CBOs.

Rift Valley Children and Women Development Organization (RCWDO) is a local Non-Governmental Organization established in 1993 G.C. It is implementing integrated rural community development programme in partnership with different international NGOs targeting people in poverty and marginalization.
