RESULTS, KEY FINDINGS AND JOINT ACTIONS SOCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

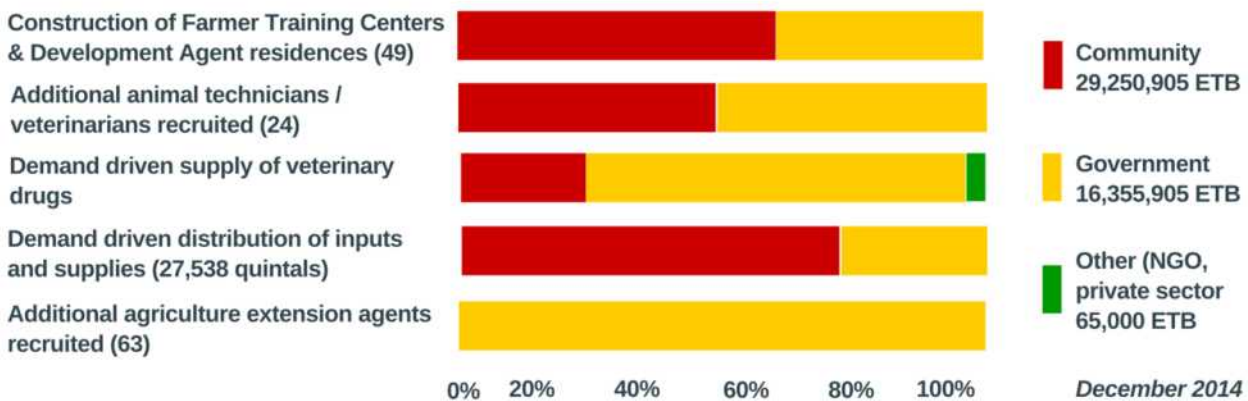
KEY PERFORMANCE ISSUES:

-  The agriculture service standard is best negotiated with farmers.
-  70 % farming households engaged in livestock rearing + crop production: diverse needs not met
-  Weak enabling environment – cooperatives, credit, rural roads, and access to markets, so low uptake improved practices
-  Development Agents do not hear farmers' views, needs and concerns.

JOINT ACTIONS:

-  Services tailored to farmers' needs: improved take up of practices
-  Wider variety of services made available: inputs and extension for crop production, livestock and veterinary services, environmental protection.
-  Location of cooperatives, rules for agriculture credit, and construction of farm roads changed to farmer preferences: improved production + credit repayment. Marketing services not yet available.
-  More information and choice. Development agents + vets are more accessible to farmers.
