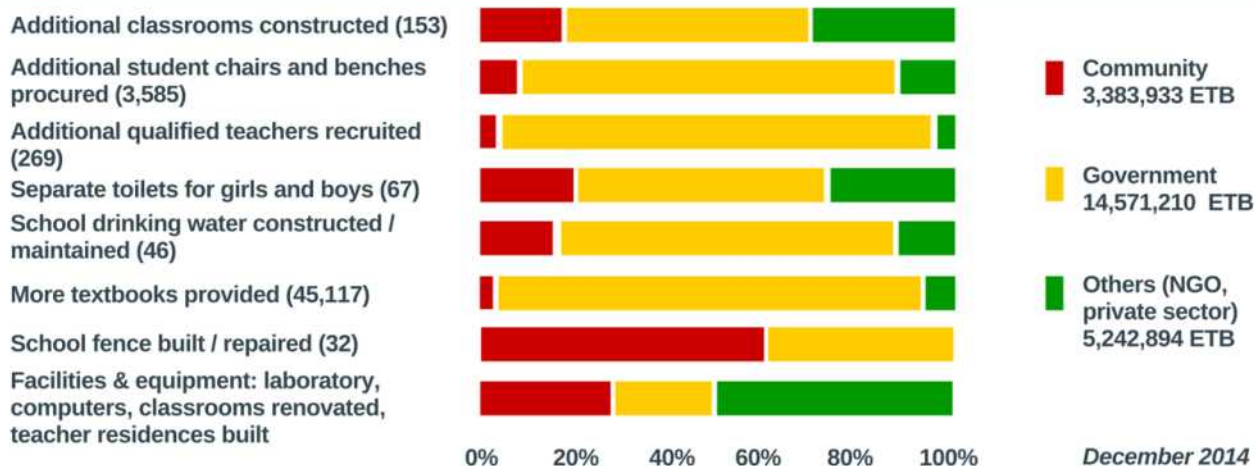


RESULTS, KEY FINDINGS AND JOINT ACTIONS SOCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

JOINT ACTIONS FOR PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT

-  Standard improved where it was not met: student-teacher, student-text book and student-desk ratios
-  Empowerment of Parent Teacher Associations: improving relationships between school actors, using budgets where they used to be left unspent
-  Vulnerable children's access to education: reduced stigma, facilities disability friendly, funds for special needs education spend
-  SA clubs in schools: raise awareness about entitlements and duties of all stakeholders, and advise students that misbehave
-  Water supply, toilet construction and access to electricity in some schools
-  Addressing challenges faced by girls: harassment stopped by fencing schools, removing bars and chat houses, and organising transport services; facilities for menstrual cycle
-  Low educational attainment addressed due to teacher training, settling step promotions, assigning specialist subjects, constructing teacher toilets & residences - As a result: less teacher absenteeism, drop-out rates reduced, and more children passed exams
